

# The Guy Zapoleon Top 1000 Los Angeles Singles of Modern Times

Guy Zapoleon is a 20-year-old UCLA psychology major with a rather odd hobby which has absorbed all his spare time since 1967: charting records and charting charts of records.

He started his charts early in 1967, shortly after his family had moved to Los Angeles from Stamford, Connecticut. His beginnings were the weekly Top 30 listings posted by KHJ, which at that time was (as it still is) the top-rated station in the area.

#### **Precious Points**

Week after week, Guy would pore over the additions, subtractions and relative movements of records within KHJ's tallies. As his collection of lists mounted, Guy developed a point system which could summarize the careers of records so they could be ranked relative to records from other time periods. A Number One record is awarded 30 points for each week it holds the position. Number Two records get 29, Number Threes 28 and so on down to Number 30, which gets one point per week. Thus a record which goes from 28 to 13 to 5 to 17 to 30 in five weeks would get (3+18+26+14 +1) 62 points for its career.

Also as his collection of lists mounted, Guy determined to broaden his base of data by researching past charts for his master listings.

Since KHJ had had a Top 30 format only since May of 1965, Guy had to leapfrog to another station for earlier figures. For approximately 6 months prior to the inception of the KHJ list, he relied on KRLA's tallies, inasmuch as KRLA was posting respectable ratings with a hit singles format during that period.

#### An Eternity of Transition

For some months in 1964 and the stretch of time back to 1958, though, there was one inevitable choice: KFWB, which dominated Los Angeles radio and defined the prevailing regional musical taste for what seemed like a musical eternity—the twilight of the 50s and the dawn of the 60s.

"Color Radio" was one title they had for their format, but it was color radio only in the sense that white is a color. During a time when black acts were finally gaining equal musical status nationally, KFWB was allowing very few raisins in the oatmeal of its music and those that slipped in slipped back out rather rapidly.

Guy Zapoleon arrived in Los Angeles too late to hear KFWB in its prime (it's now an all-news station, and doing well), but he did manage to get access to their charts, which he merged with his KRLA and KHJ figures to arrive at some all-time tabulations.

#### Fourteen Years' Worth of Weeks

Guy's master chart these days numbers 1,000 records, a list compiled from lists beginning in May of 1958 (he's been unable to find earlier surveys) and reaching all the way up to next week.

Since this accounting of the

Top 1,000 derives from two primary sources, each of approximately equal weight (six and a half years of KFWB versus seven and a half years of KHJ, plus half a year of KRLA, whose content is closer to KHJ's than KFWB), and since the two sources display significant differences, even apart from their periods of time, the resulting list has a fascinating schizophrenic character.

KHJ is the flagship station of the Bill Drake programming chain and as a limb of an organization with national scope usually conforms fairly closely with the taste of the nation as revealed in trade paper charts, though KHJ also breaks and plays some purely regional hits.

#### The Rocker Meets the Popper

In addition, KHJ has always been a rock station—as opposed to a pop station, a term which comes closer to defining KFWB's onetime identity—and has consistently played a goodly portion of records which began as rhythm and blues or soul hits. Another difference between the two sources which becomes apparent with a look at the Top 50 portion of the list is that KFWB's chart changed less rapidly than KHJ's did (and does), allowing the biggest KFWB hits to outpoint the biggest KHJ hits.

What follows is Guy's midsummer 1972 Top 1,000, a list highly peculiar to Southern California because of KFWB's programming and charting techniques, because of the contrast between KFWB and KHJ and because (of course) of the natural strangeness of Los Angeles.

The schism between Mr. Zapoleon's various sources is easily spotted within the list, which Circular herewith reprints




